The RLS Geneva office, which has worked extensively on statelessness by means of publications and conferences, would like to create a podcast series on this topic. This podcast series should address the issues that are faced by stateless people and the policies in place to fight against statelessness. The details of the series will be discussed between the selected candidate and RLS Geneva.

For this, RLS Geneva is looking for a production company for a 6-month project to research, create and produce a podcast series on statelessness.

Summary of the tasks:

- Researching the topic of statelessness with the help of RLS and its network
- Identifying opportunities and organizing interviews
- Producing all components of the podcast series
- Reporting on the activities
